Dear ATEE 2005 contributor,

Now that the 2005 ATEE conference is well behind us the Organising Committee is currently working on the creation of the post-conference website.

#### **Criteria**

All papers that have been presented at the conference will be published on the post-conference website, supplemented by a print on demand system. Before papers will be uploaded to the post-conference website they will be reviewed by the chairs of the sessions in which they have been presented. The following criteria will be applied in the reviewing of papers (please note that these criteria are identical to the criteria used for the selection of abstracts by the Academic Committee):

- The text of a full paper should be no longer than 4000 words (footnotes, references etc. not included).
- Contributions may be research reports, descriptions of ongoing research, reports on literature studies, essays, discussion papers or descriptions of programmes. *They all should have a direct bearing on the theme of the conference or the theme of one of the RDC's.*
- Contributions must present innovative content that has not been presented at another conference or submitted to or published in a journal.
- The content of the papers should contribute to or raise questions on the discussions on teacher education (on an international level).
- In research reports or descriptions of ongoing research there has to be a clear description of the research method used.

#### **Deadline**

On 30 November 2005 the papers will be sent out to the chairs for reviewing. Please make sure that the Organising Committee has the final version of your paper by 30 November 2005. You can send in your paper as an email attachment to [papers@atee2005.nl](mailto:papers@atee2005.nl). The post-conference website will go online on 1 April 2006.
